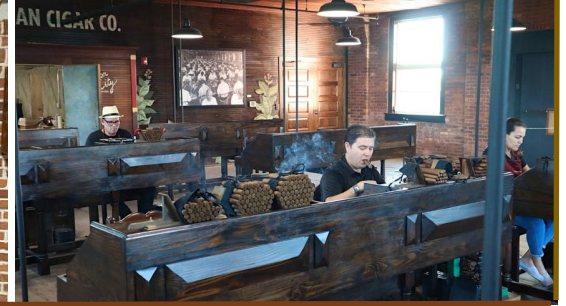




Tour Historic Ybor City

Birthplace of Tampa's
Iconic Cigar Industry and
Unique Cultural Community



TOUR INCLUDES:

Ybor City Museum State Park: Housed in an historic Italian Bakery, featuring original wood-burning brick ovens, Tampa's early pioneers and the ethnic groups who settled Ybor.

Tampa Baseball Museum: Located in the 1905 childhood home "casita" of Al Lopez, Tampa's first Major League player, manager and Hall of Fame Inductee; features 130+ years of Tampa's baseball history.

Lunch in the Idyllic and Peaceful Museum Gardens: Catered by La Segunda Central Bakery, premiere bakers of Cuban bread who have been in business for more than 100 years.

J.C. Newman Cigar Factory and Museum: Guided tour of a three-story museum in Tampa's last operating cigar factory. The building's moniker is "El Reloj" for its prominent clock tower that chimed hourly to keep time for the community. Take a walk back in time and see cigars hand rolled in the rolling room.
